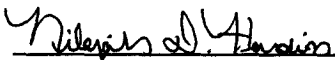
On December 8, 2017, the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services ("Department") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's clinical substance abuse counselor certificate with the condition that he fully comply with the terms of the Final Decision and Order issued by the Wisconsin Professional Counselor Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Work Examining Board ("Section") on December 5, 2017 (ORDER0005534).

Respondent has submitted a request for removal of the limitations and the return of his certificate to full, unrestricted status. Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Respondent has completed the terms of the order issued by the Section, the following is entered:
