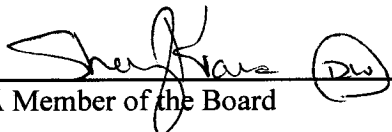
On December 14, 2017, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions including, but not limited to, completion of an Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse (AODA) assessment by an evaluator pre-approved by the Board or its designee who has experience conducting these assessments.

On April 12, 2018, the Board reviewed the report resulting from Respondent's AODA assessment. Based upon the information of record and the terms of the Order, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent timely completed the required AODA assessment. The results of the AODA assessment and evaluator's recommendations do not provide a basis to impose additional limitations. Therefore, Respondent's professional nursing license (#219645-30) is hereby returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are hereby removed.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
