On December 15, 2017, the Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent Smith to pay a forfeiture in the amount of \$5000.00 and costs of the proceeding in the amount of \$2,228.00, via \$1807.00 payments on January 15, 2018, April 15, 2018, August 15, 2018 and December 15, 2018. The information of record demonstrates that Respondent Smith has failed to pay the forfeiture and costs of the proceeding as ordered and, as a result, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent Smith's cosmetology license (#74781-82) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent has paid the forfeiture and costs of the proceeding in full.
