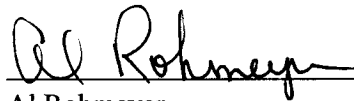
You are hereby notified that your Dwelling Contractor credential is suspended for seven days, beginning on September 10, 2018.

The basis for this suspension is the work you performed at 11105 Meadow Ridge Road, Whitelaw, Wisconsin 54247. You installed a deck at this site. You failed to obtain a building permit before starting construction. The footings were also shown to be improperly sized and not as deep as the Uniform Dwelling Code requires, by an inspection report from City of Manitowoc Inspector Rich Schwartz. This conduct is a violation of Wis. Admin. Code §§ SPS 320.08(1), 321.15(2)(f), and 321.16.

The above conduct constitutes incompetence under Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.10(1)(a)3. This violation is a basis for discipline pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code ch. SPS 305.

After the suspension, you may request, in writing, to have your credential reinstated. The reinstatement process is set forth in Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.10(1)(f). You have the right to request a hearing on the suspension by sending a request for hearing to the Department of Safety and Professional Services, Chief Legal Counsel, P.O. Box 8368, Madison, Wisconsin 53708-8368, which must be received by the Department no later than 30 days from the date of mailing of this Notice. Any hearing on the suspension will be held in accordance with the requirements set forth in Wis. Stat. ch. 227.
