ORDER

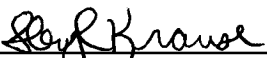
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that, pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 440.22, the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$1,759.41. are hereby assessed against the Respondent, and shall be payable by the Respondent to the Department of Safety and Professional Services. **Failure of the Respondent to make payment on or before March 8, 2019, shall constitute a violation of the Order unless the Respondent petitions for and the Board grants a different deadline.** Under Wis. Stats. §440.22(3), the Department of Safety and Professional Services may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to the Respondent until the Respondent has made payment to the Department in the full amount assessed.
