On January 30, 2018, the Wisconsin Professional Counselor Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Work Examining Board ("Section") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional counselor license. Respondent was required to complete six (6) hours of education on the topic of "ethics," six (6) hours on the topic of "professional boundaries," and six (6) hours on the topic of "clinical supervision" pursuant to the terms of the Order.
