On January 30, 2018, the Wisconsin Social Worker Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Work Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to pay \$842.00 in costs of the proceeding within 120 days from the date Order. Respondent was also required to complete six (6) hours of education on the topic of confidentiality law applicable to the social work field within 90 days from the date of the Order.

The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to pay the costs of the proceeding and to complete the education requirements. Therefore, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's advanced practice social work certificate in the state of Wisconsin (#130088-121) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent has paid the costs of the proceeding in full and has demonstrated successful completion of the education requirements of the Order.
