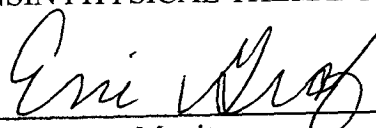
On February 7, 2018, the Wisconsin Physical Therapy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's physical therapist assistant license. Respondent was required to complete 4 hours of education in documentation/fraud/billing or a combination of such topics pursuant to the terms of the Order.
