On February 8, 2018, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with several terms and conditions, including the successful completion of four (4) hours of education in "medication dispensing," five (5) hours in "documentation," and four (4) hours in "ethics in nursing" within 90 days. Pursuant to the Order, Respondent's license may be suspended, without further notice or hearing, for violation of any of the terms and conditions.

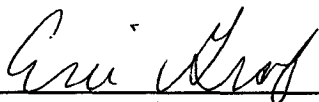
The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to comply with the education requirements of the Order and as a result, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's professional nursing license (#198050-30) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent demonstrates compliance with the terms of the Order.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.

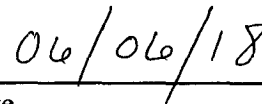
