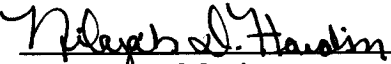
On February 13, 2018, the Wisconsin Real Estate Appraisers Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's certified residential appraiser license. Respondent was required to complete fifteen (15) hours of USPAP education and thirty (30) hours of education on any of the following topics: Residential Sales Comparison and Income Approach; Basic Appraisal Principles; Advanced Residential Applications and Case Studies; or Residential Site Valuation and Costs Approach, pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's certified residential appraiser license (#20-9) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are removed.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
