Jerry Jerue, via his attorney Dawn Marie Harris, submitted written notice of voluntary surrender of his Hearing Instrument Specialist license. The notice provided that the surrender was effective February 27, 2018, and was signed by Mr. Jerue on the same date (see attached). Mr. Jerue is currently subject to limitations on his license related to case number 14 HAD 010, a disciplinary matter.

Wisconsin Stat. § 440.19 allows the Hearing and Speech Examining Board (Board) to refuse to accept a voluntary surrender if a disciplinary proceeding has been commenced against the credential holder who wishes to surrender their license. Although the limitations related to case number 14 HAD 010 are unresolved, the Board accepts Mr. Jerue's voluntary surrender, effective February 27, 2018. As such, Mr. Jerue is no longer licensed to practice as a Hearing Instrument Specialist in Wisconsin; and, the restrictions related to case number 14 HAD 010 are no longer applicable to Mr. Jerue.
