FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Dentistry Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Sham S. Chandok, D.D.S., (DOB September 11, 1950) is licensed in the state of Wisconsin to practice dentistry, having license number 3107-15, first issued on April 14, 1983, and current through September 30, 2019. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 5542 West Fond du Lac Avenue, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53216.

2. At all times relevant to this proceeding, Respondent was employed as a dentist at a clinic (the clinic) located in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

3. On February 4, 2016, Patient A, a minor child, presented to Respondent at the clinic for a periodic exam and radiographs. The patient progress notes indicated that Patient A should have “fillings” at her next visit, but the plan did not indicate where the fillings were to be placed.

4. On August 15, 2016, Patient A presented to Respondent for a periodic exam. Respondent diagnosed three (3) pit-and-fissure cavities with incipient lesions on teeth #18, #30, and #31. Respondent further recommended the extraction of tooth #A. The patient progress notes document that Respondent did extract tooth #A.

5. On October 20, 2016, Dr. R, in the same practice, saw Patient A for filling restorations on teeth #18, #30, and #31. After Patient A’s appointment, Patient A’s mother discussed with Dr. R her concern that there was a cavity on tooth #15.

6. Dr. R did a quick exam on tooth #15 and noted that it looked like the tooth cusp had fractured on the top left, and that it could be a new issue that developed after the last periodic exam on February 4, 2016.

7. Because Patient A did not report pain in tooth #15, Dr. R recommended that another appointment be set up for an exam and radiographic image.

8. On December 5, 2016, Patient A was seen by a subsequent treater at another practice. Radiographs from this visit show a deep lesion on tooth #15.

9. Based on the severity of the caries on tooth #15 as evidenced by the December 5, 2016, radiographs, a minimally competent dentist in the state of Wisconsin should have diagnosed such caries from the radiographs taken on February 4, 2016, and clinically during the exam on August 15, 2016.

10. By failing to timely diagnose the decay, Respondent created the unacceptable risk that the tooth would deteriorate and need to be extracted.

11. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 447.07, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Sham S. Chandok, D.D.S., engaged in unprofessional conduct as defined by Wis. Admin. Code § DE 5.02(5), by practicing in a manner which substantially departs from the standard of care ordinarily exercised by a dentist which harms or could have harmed a patient.

3. As a result of the above violations, Sham S. Chandok, D.D.S., is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 447.07(3)(a).

ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
2. Respondent Sham S. Chandok, D.D.S., is REPRIMANDED.
3. The license to practice dentistry issued to Sham S. Chandok, D.D.S., (license number 3107-15) is LIMITED as follows:
 - a. Within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order, Respondent shall successfully complete eight (8) hours of education on the topic of diagnosis and treatment planning, eight (8) hours of education on the topic of radiographic evaluation and interpretation, and eight (8) hours of education on the topic of risk management, offered by a provider pre-approved by the Board's monitoring liaison. Successful completion includes taking and passing any exam offered for the courses.
 - b. All education completed pursuant to this Order shall be taken in-person. Education such as webinar, online, or self-study shall not be approved.
 - c. Respondent shall submit proof of successful completion of the ordered education in the form of verification from the institution providing the education to the Department Monitor at the address stated below.
 - d. None of the education completed pursuant to this requirement may be used to satisfy any continuing education requirements that have been or may be instituted by the Board or Department, and also may not be used in future attempts to upgrade a credential in Wisconsin.
 - e. This limitation shall be removed from Respondent's license after satisfying the Board or its designee that Respondent has successfully completed all of the ordered education.
4. Within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, Sham S. Chandok, D.D.S., shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$375.03.
5. Requests for course preapproval, proof of satisfactory completion of courses, and payment of costs (made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services) shall be sent by Respondent to the Department Monitor at the address below:



In the event that Respondent violates any term of this Order, Respondent's license (no. 3107-15) to practice dentistry in the state of Wisconsin may, in the discretion of the Board or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of the Order. The Board may, in addition and/or in the alternative refer any violation of this Order to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further investigation and action.

7. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.

STIPULATION

Division of Legal Services and Compliance Case No. 16 DEN 104

Respondent Sham S. Chandok, D.D.S., and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services stipulate as follows:

1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.

2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:

- the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
- the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
- the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
- the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
- the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
- the right to petition for rehearing; and
- all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.

3. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.

4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board (Board). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.


5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division

of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that the Stipulation is not accepted by the Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.



The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Board ever assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Board in open or closed session, without the presence of Respondent, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Board may have in connection with deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Board should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.

7. Respondent is informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.

8. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
