A Notice of Hearing was filed in this matter on May 15, 2018. Prior to the hearing on the formal complaint, the parties have agreed to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department). The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Greg Dudzik, is permitted in the State of Wisconsin as a Dwelling Contractor Qualifier, having certificate number 1000122, which is current through July 24, 2018. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Department is 1082 Coronada Court, Oneida, Wisconsin, 54155.

2. The Department became aware Respondent had been charged in Brown County Circuit Court, case number 15 CF 1419, with several felonies related to his work as a Dwelling Contractor Qualifier.

3. On May 19, 2017, the Respondent was convicted of two felony counts of Theft by a Contractor and sentenced to three years of probation.

4. On March 20, 2017, the Department opened matter 17 COM 034, to address Respondent's felony convictions.

5. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 101.63(2m), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent Greg Dudzik violated Wisconsin Administrative Code § SPS 305.10(1)(a)6 by being convicted for a crime substantially related to the license, certification or registration.

3. As a result of the violations noted in the Conclusions of Law, Respondent Greg Dudzik is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 101.63(2m).

ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.

2. Respondent Greg Dudzik's certification is SUSPENDED FOR a period of sixty (60) days beginning on the date this order is signed.

3. After the sixty (60) day suspension, the Respondent may request to have his credential reinstated. The reinstatement process is set forth in Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.10(1)(f). The request must be made in writing and mailed to the Department of Safety and Professional Services, P.O. Box 8368, Madison, Wisconsin 53708-8368.

4. The request for hearing made by Respondent dated March 16, 2018, is hereby withdrawn.

5. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Department in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order.

6. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
