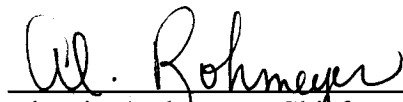
On June 14, 2018 the Department considered Respondent's request for removal of the words "Limited – See Order" from his physical license. Based upon the information of record, the Department makes the following:
