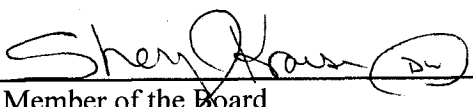
On April 12, 2018, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued an Order Granting Limited License ("Order") limiting Applicant's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions.
