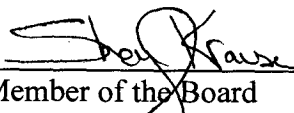
On April 10, 2018, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued an Order Granting Limited Licensure ("Order"), limiting Applicant's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions, including participation in a drug monitoring program.

On May 10, 2018, the Board considered Applicant's request for acceptance of drug and alcohol testing through Minnesota's Health Professionals Services Program ("HPSP") and termination of the treatment requirement. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:
