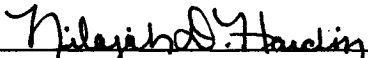
On April 11, 2018, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's pharmacist license. Respondent was required to complete five (5) hours of education on the topic of patient confidentiality pursuant to the terms of the Order.
