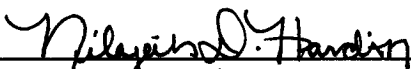
On April 19, 2018, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's real estate broker license. Respondent was required to complete three hours of education on the topic of "contracts," three hours on "approved forms," and three hours on "trust accounts" pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that she successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's real estate broker license (#38387-90) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are removed.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
