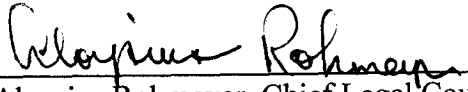
On April 26, 2018, the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's clinical substance abuse counselor and independent clinical supervisor credentials for an indefinite period. Respondent's credentials were also limited requiring her to complete four (4) hours of pre-approved education on the topic of "ethics," and four (4) hours on the topic of "documentation or record keeping."

Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Respondent has now completed the education, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. The suspension is terminated and Respondent's clinical substance abuse counselor and independent clinical supervisor certificates (#1842-132 and 1189-135) are hereby returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are removed.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
