The Department charges copying fees. *All requests must cite the case number, the date of the order, and respondent's name* as it appears on the order.
- Reported decisions may have an appeal pending, and discipline may be stayed during the appeal. Information about the current status of a credential issued by the Department of Safety and Professional Services is shown on the Department's Web Site under "License Lookup."

You are hereby notified that your Master Electrician license (#171876) is suspended for fourteen days, beginning on July 16, 2018.

The basis for this suspension is the electrical work you performed at W7981 Teeter Road, Poynette, Wisconsin 53955. An inspection by a Department of Safety and Professional Services Inspector Craig Mulder found four electrical violations present at the home, including installing NM cable without protection from physical damage, not securing or supporting NM cable, and installing NM cable in a space that is used for environmental air handling purposes.

The above conduct constitutes incompetence under Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.10(1)(a)3. This violation is a basis for discipline pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code ch. SPS 305.

After the suspension, you may request, in writing, to have your credential reinstated. The reinstatement process is set forth in Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.10(1)(f).

You have the right to request a hearing on the suspension by sending a request for hearing to the Department of Safety and Professional Services, Chief Legal Counsel, P.O. Box 8368, Madison, Wisconsin 53708-8368, which must be received by the Department no later than 30 days from the date of mailing of this Notice. Any hearing on the suspension will be held in accordance with the requirements set forth in Wis. Stat. ch. 227.
