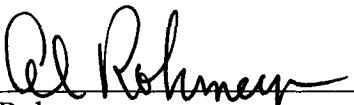

You are hereby notified that you are subject to an administrative forfeiture of \$1,000.00 in accordance with Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.125(1)(b)1. This forfeiture must be paid within 30 days of the date of mailing of this Notice, or a 12% interest penalty will be assessed.

You have the right to request a review of the assessment of forfeiture by sending a request to the Division Administrator, Division of Industry Services, P.O. Box 7302, Madison, Wisconsin 53707-7302, which must be received by the Division no later than 30 days from the date of mailing of this Notice. Any review of the assessment of forfeiture will be held in accordance with the requirements set forth in Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.125(6-8).

You are receiving this administrative forfeiture because you installed private onsite wastewater treatment systems throughout Oneida County without a master plumber license and without pulling sanitary permits. Oneida County cited you numerous times for these actions, specifically, 8966 Forestwood Lane, Woodruff, Wisconsin, 11842 Franklin Lake Road, Minocqua, Wisconsin, and 9280 Heatherwood Lane, Minocqua, Wisconsin. Your actions violated Wis. Stat. §§ 145.06(1)(a) and 145.19(1g), and Wis. Admin. Code §§ SPS 383.21(1)(a) and 305.90(1)(a). The administrative forfeiture of \$1,000.00 is assessed in accordance with Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.125(1)(b)1.
