On May 10, 2018, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to pay \$775.00 in costs, within 120 days from the date of the Order. Respondent was also required to complete four (4) hours of education in "medication errors" and five (5) hours in documentation, within 90 days from the date of the Order.

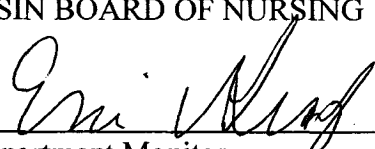
The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to pay the costs of the proceeding and to complete the education requirements. Therefore, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's right to renew her professional nursing license (#164391-30) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. Respondent's right to renew her advanced practice nurse prescriber certificate (#4144-33) is hereby SUSPENDED.
3. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent has paid the costs of the proceeding, including accrued interest, in full and has demonstrated successful completion of the education requirements of the Order.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
