On June 14, 2018, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's right to renew her professional nursing license, as well as her privilege to practice in Wisconsin pursuant to the Nurse Licensure Compact (original and enhanced). Respondent was required to complete four (4) hours of education on the topic of ethics and five (5) hours of education on the topic of professional accountability, pursuant to the terms of the Order.

ORDER

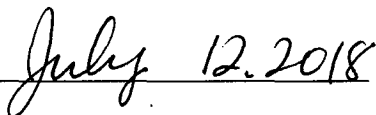
