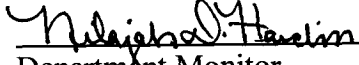
On June 14, 2018, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's real estate salesperson license. Respondent was required to complete six (6) hours of education on the topic of real estate business practices and ethics pursuant to the terms of the Order.
