On June 28, 2018, the Wisconsin Funeral Directors Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent Thor J. Thorson's funeral director license for a period of fifteen (15) days beginning fourteen (14) calendar days after the date of the Order. Respondent Thorson Funeral Home's funeral establishment permit was also limited with certain terms and conditions.

Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that a Wisconsin licensed funeral director served as the funeral director in charge for the duration of Respondent Thor J. Thorson's suspension, the Board's designee finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. The suspension of Respondent Thor J. Thorson's funeral director license (#4061-77) is deemed served.
2. Respondent Thorson Funeral Home's funeral establishment permit (#1521-78) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
3. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent Thorson Funeral Home's credential are hereby removed.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
