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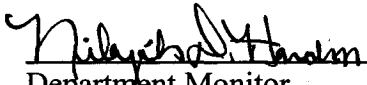
On August 21, 2018, the Wisconsin Psychology Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's psychologist license. Respondent was required to complete six (6) hours of education if taken in person or twelve (12) hours of education if taken online, on the topic of "record keeping or documentation." Respondent was also required to complete six (6) hours of education if taken in person or twelve (12) hours of education if taken online, on the topic of "time management for professionals" pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that she successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:

1. Respondent's psychologist license (#2831-57) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are removed.
