INVESTIGATION NOTES:

This DEPARTMENT ORDER is issued as a result of an inspection on the above referenced site (17 COM 079).

The following violations were revealed:

1. Violation: The existing POWTS serving the restrooms is no longer functional.

Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 382.22(1)(a): All plumbing systems, both existing and new, and all parts thereof, shall be maintained in a safe and sanitary condition.

Required Action: The POWTS system should be repaired, replaced or the restrooms should be abandoned by removing the plumbing fixtures and capping the piping.

2. Violation: The water supply is not suitable for consumption.

Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 382.10(2)(a): Every building intended for human occupancy shall be provided with an adequate, safe and potable water supply.

Required Action: Water supply should be tested and remediated.

3. Violation: Exterior hose bibb did not have cross connection control.

Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 382.41(3): Cross connection control. General Requirements: Water supply systems and the connection of each plumbing fixture, piece of equipment, appliance or nonpotable water piping system shall be designed, installed and maintained in such a manner to prevent the contamination of water supplies by means of cross connections


Required Action: Install cross connection control.

You are hereby ordered to have the installation corrected to conform to the indicated provisions of the Wisconsin Administrative Code and/or Wisconsin Statutes. This installation shall be corrected by the compliance date noted, and upon correction of violations I must be notified. If you fail to comply, this order is enforceable in circuit court pursuant to Wis. Stat. §101.02(13), Stats., with forfeitures ranging from \$10 to \$100 per day for each violation.

Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 303.03 Permits any person affected by a rule of the department to petition for a variance of the rule. The petition needs to establish equivalency to the rule, be provided on the form from the department and be submitted with accompanying fee and municipal recommendation.

Wis. Stat. § 101.02(6)(e) stats. Any employer or other person interested either because of ownership in or occupation of any property affected by any such order, or otherwise, may petition for a hearing on the reasonableness of any order of the department in the manner provided in this subchapter. Any petition for a hearing must be received within 30 days of the date of the Order.
