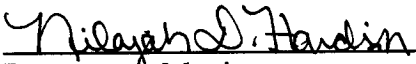
On October 23, 2018, the Wisconsin Social Worker Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Work Examining Board ("Section") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's social worker certificate. Respondent was required to complete six (6) hours of education on the topic of "confidentiality and ethics for social workers" pursuant to the terms of the Order.
