The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Licensee Debbie S. Vigil, R.N., (DOB October 29, 1959) is not licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a registered nurse, but has a multi-state registered nurse license in Utah, license number 325958-3102, a registered nurse license in Minnesota, license number 2423753, a registered nurse license in California, license number 95145324, and a registered nurse license in Wyoming, license number 26499, which allowed her to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin. Licensee's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 21 West Wasatch Street, Midvale, Utah 84047.
- 2. At all times relevant to this proceeding, Licensee was employed as a travelling registered nurse for a staffing agency on an assignment at a medical center (Center) located in Elkhorn, Wisconsin.

- 3. On June 1, 2016, Licensee began a thirteen (13) month assignment at the Center.
- 4. On July 20, 2016, the Center's Pyxis alerted the HR Director and Chief Nursing Officer to suspicious pulls of Versed® 2 mg/mL over a span of a few months.
- 5. On July 21, 2016, Licensee was interviewed by the Center's Loss Prevention and agreed to submit to a reasonable suspicion 13-panel drug screen.
- 6. The results of the drug screen showed Licensee was negative for all thirteen substances tested. Licensee asserts that she did not divert any medications and that she did not otherwise use a medication except as lawfully prescribed to her.
- 7. During the July 21, 2016 interview with Loss Prevention, Licensee admitted to making charting errors and improperly scanning the medications being administered to patients.
 - 8. Licensee's assignment with the Center was terminated.
- 9. On August 26, 2018, and August 27, 2018, Licensee voluntarily completed four (4) hours of education on the topic of Medication Errors: Causes and Prevention, and five (5) hours of education on Documentation: A Critical Aspect of Client Care.
- 10. In resolution of this matter, Licensee consents to the entry of the following Conclusion of Law and Order.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

- 1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
- 2. The Board recognizes the aforementioned continuing education courses as the equivalent of the education the Board would have otherwise required.
 - 3. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.

Licensee Debbie S. Vigil, R.N., and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services stipulate as follows:

- 1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Licensee consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.
- 2. Licensee understands that by signing this Stipulation, Licensee voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:
 - the right to a hearing on the allegations against Licensee, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
 - the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Licensee;
 - the right to call witnesses on Licensee's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
 - the right to testify on Licensee's own behalf;
 - the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
 - the right to petition for rehearing; and
 - all other applicable rights afforded to Licensee under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.
- 3. Licensee is aware of Licensee's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation. Licensee is represented by Attorney Mario Mendoza.
- 4. Licensee agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Licensee waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.

- Fig. writes of this Superlation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bestal by the consents of this Superlation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division of Logal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that the Supulation is one accepted by the Beent the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or bassed in was manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.
- The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Board ever assigned as an ach iser in this investigation may appear before the Board in open or closed session, without the presence of Licensee or Licensee's attorney, for purposes of speaking in support of this servering questions that any member of the Board may have in connection with deliberations on the Supulation. Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Board should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
- 7. Licensee is informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.
- The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Licensee in recommending the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
