You are hereby notified that your Dwelling Contractor Certification (DC-070800022, Customer ID: 1080992, 1080994) is suspended for seven days starting January 28, 2019, and expiring February 4, 2019.

The basis for this suspension is you were negligent in your responsibilities as a Dwelling Contractor at 1060 N. Knowles Avenue, New Richmond, WI 54017. As a dwelling contractor you are responsible for obtaining the proper permit prior to commencing construction. An investigation determined that you never obtained a permit for the work performed at the above address. The City of New Richmond confirmed it required a permit for re-siding and re-roofing for at least 15 years. It is your responsibility to confirm if a permit is required. New Richmond's website clearly states a permit is required for the work you performed.

The above conduct constitutes a violation of a state law under Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.31(4)(b). This action was a negligent act and is a basis for discipline pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.10(a)(3).

After the suspension, you may request, in writing, to have your credential reinstated. The reinstatement process is set forth in Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.10(1)(f). You can email your request to dspscredtrades@wisconsin.gov.

You have the right to request a hearing on the suspension by sending a request for hearing to the Department of Safety and Professional Services, Chief Legal Counsel, P.O. Box 7190, Madison, Wisconsin 53707-7190, which must be received by the Department no later than 30 days from the date of mailing of this Notice. Any hearing on the suspension will be held in accordance with the requirements set forth in Wis. Stat. ch. 227.
