The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Medical Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent David M. Hammond-Koskey, P.A. (DOB October 2, 1953), is licensed by the State of Wisconsin as a physician assistant, having license number 347-23, first issued on March 11, 1983. Respondent's registration expired February 28, 2018 while suspended.

2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 3720 W. Hansen Road, Ludington, Michigan 49431.

3. On April 20, 2005, the Board entered a Final Decision and Order for Remedial Education (Order LS0504202MED) in resolution of DLSC case number 05 MED 029. The order required Respondent to take eight (8) hours of continuing medical education on medical record keeping and documentation.

4. On June 25, 2016, the Board entered a Final Decision and Order (Order 0004759) in resolution of DLSC case number 14 MED 308. The Board reprimanded Respondent and required Respondent to pay \$500.00 in costs and complete 10 hours of continuing education on medical ethics.

5. By Order dated December 1, 2017, Respondent's license was suspended based upon his failure to comply with the Board's June 25, 2016 Order. It has not been renewed.

6. Respondent has notified the Department that he is retired and will not be renewing his Wisconsin physician assistant license.

7. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent David J. Hammond-Koskey, P.A., engaged in unprofessional conduct as defined by Wis. Stat. § Med 10.03(1)(a) by violating a valid order of the Board.

3. As a result of the above conduct, David M. Hammond-Koskey, P.A., is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3).

#### ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.

2. The PERMANENT SURRENDER by David M. Hammond-Koskey, P.A., of his license to practice as a physician assistant in the State of Wisconsin (license no. 347-23) and any appurtenant right to renew that license, is hereby accepted, effective the date of this Order.

3. This surrender constitutes Respondent's permanent relinquishment of his right to practice as a physician assistant in the State of Wisconsin. The Board will not, at any time in the future, process or otherwise consider an application or attempt at renewal by Respondent of credentials necessary to practice as a physician assistant in the state of Wisconsin.

4. If Respondent ever seeks any other license under Wis. Stat. chs. 440-480, David M. Hammond-Koskey, P.A., shall, as a prerequisite to application, pay COSTS of this matter in

the amount of \$ 627.00. If Respondent never again seeks licensure in Wisconsin, the Department waives the above-stated costs.

5. If applicable, payment of costs would be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services and sent to the Department Monitor at the address below:



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STIPULATION

Respondent David M. Hammond-Koskey, P.A., and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services stipulate as follows:

1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.
2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:
  - the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
  - the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
  - the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
  - the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
  - the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
  - the right to petition for rehearing; and
  - all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.
3. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.
4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board (Board). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.
5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division



of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that the Stipulation is not accepted by the Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.

6. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Board ever assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Board in open or closed session, without the presence of Respondent, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Board may have in connection with deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Board should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.

7. Respondent is informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.

8. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
