The Ed.D. in Leadership is a terminal degree with a dissertation requiring original research. The program can be accomplished by working professionals.

ED.S. IN LEADERSHIP

34 SEMESTER CREDITS | \$306/CREDIT | APPROX 1.5-2 YEARS

The Ed.S. in Leadership is a practitioner's degree at the post-master's level for those who seek advanced credentials but not a full doctoral degree with a dissertation requirement. The objective of the degree is to develop skills and competencies that will make the student a more effective leader. The degree does not lead to professional licensure, nor does it include an internship. Coursework from the Ed.S. may apply to the Ed.D. in Leadership.

Students in the Ed.D. & Ed.S. in Leadership programs will:

- Collaborate in diverse communities of learning and build partnerships with states, school districts, or other organizations
- Contribute to solutions for complex problems of practice
- Analyze and promote best practices in leadership
- Demonstrate evidence-based decision-making, integrating principles of equity, ethics, and social justice
- Develop and implement personal and organization-level knowledge and skills including technology
- Demonstrate mastery of content knowledge through the utilization of critical and creative thinking
- Demonstrate competence in the application of multiple research methods
- Contribute to professional knowledge bases through the dissemination of applied research

Certificate in Advanced Graduate Study

The Certificate in Advanced Graduate Study (CAGS) is a post-master's certificate of advanced study.

- Students can specialize in Leadership, Teaching and Learning, or Interdisciplinary Educational Studies
- Structured for those seeking to enhance graduate level skills through a student-designed program of study, this certificate offers a range of selected courses tailored to align to personal and professional goals
- The certificate includes nine courses plus a three credit project based capstone course, for a total of 30 semester hours
- Certain credits earned in the CAGS program are transferrable to the Ed.S. or Ed.D. in Leadership at American College of Education
