With STST credentials, graduates earn up to 10 Ford Instructor-led classroom credentials plus 80 required web-based credentials, resulting in the completion of 7 Ford STST certification areas and progress in 2 additional areas. Students also can achieve 5 Quick Lane certifications with Ford's Quick Service and Light Repair training.
