

On November 9, 2010, the Wisconsin Funeral Directors Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's funeral director license with certain terms and conditions.

On February 19, 2019, the Board considered Respondent's request for removal of the limitations and the return of her license to full, unrestricted status. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of her funeral director license (#5626-77) to full, unrestricted status is hereby GRANTED.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are hereby removed.
