
On September 12, 2012, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's pharmacist license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On February 27, 2019, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return of full licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's pharmacist license (#9573-40) is hereby returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are hereby removed.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
