On February 20, 2013, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) suspending Respondent’s license to practice as a physician assistant for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On July 17, 2019, the Board considered Respondent’s request for reinstatement of full licensure, or reduction in drug and alcohol screens and access to controlled substances. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent’s request for reinstatement of full licensure or a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby DENIED for failure to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance under the terms of the Order.
2. Respondent’s request for the ability to practice in a setting in which she has access to controlled substances is hereby GRANTED.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
