

On June 18, 2013, the Wisconsin Real Estate Appraisers Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete 28 hours of approved continuing education for the 2009-2011 biennium within 45 days. Respondent was also required to complete 75 hours of additional approved education within six months, pursuant to the terms of the Order. The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to comply with the education requirements and as a result the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's licensed appraiser credential (#1931-4) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent has demonstrated successful completion of the education requirements of the Order.
