ORDER SUPENDING LICENSE ORDER0002518

On July 11, 2013, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions. Pursuant to the Order, the Board in its discretion may impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any terms of the Order.

Information has been received that demonstrates that Respondent is in violation of the terms of the Order. As a result, the following is entered:

<u>ORDER</u>

- 1. Respondent's practical nurse license (#34331-31) is hereby SUSPENDED for violation of sections 3f and 6 of the ORDER. The suspension is in effect pending Board receipt and review of a fitness to practice assessment with an evaluator preapproved by the Board. The evaluator must have experience evaluating and treating health care professionals. The assessment should address, but is not limited to:
 - A. History of any prior substance and alcohol use, including any treatment or diagnoses, efforts to stop use and outcomes (if applicable):
 - B. Current readiness to change behavior;
 - C. General medical and psychiatric history;
 - D. Any family history of substance/alcohol use and psychiatric disorders (if applicable):
 - E. Social history (family and peer relationships, financial and legal problems);
 - F. Educational and occupational history:
 - G. Diagnosis, treatment recommendation(s) (if applicable); and
 - H. Professional opinion on Applicant's fitness to practice professional nursing pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.001(4).
- 2. The two (2) year period requiring direct supervision and work setting pre-approval by the Board that is referenced in section 3(c) of the Order is extended for an additional two (2) years.

- 3. The Board may impose additional limitations based on the result of the assessment and evaluator's recommendations.
- 4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
