On April 10, 2014, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued an Order of Reinstatement of License ("Order") granting reinstatement of Respondent's pharmacy license and suspending the license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.


On February 27, 2019, the Board considered Respondent's request for pharmacist-in-charge hours and a reduction in testing frequency. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for pharmacist-in-charge-hours is hereby GRANTED as follows: Respondent may engage in the practice of pharmacy without the presence of another pharmacist for up to sixteen (16) hours per week.
2. Respondent's request for a reduction in testing frequency is hereby DENIED due to failure to achieve full compliance with the terms of the Order.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
