On September 9, 2014, the Wisconsin Professional Counselor Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Work Examining Board ("Section") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional counselor license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.


On October 15, 2019, the Section considered Respondent's request for termination of the treatment limitations and practice limitation relating to the treatment of male clients. Based upon the information of record, the Section finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a termination of the treatment requirements, outlined in provisions C.1.-C.6. of the Order, is GRANTED upon discharge by her current treatment provider.
2. Respondent's request for termination of the practice limitation relating to the treatment of male clients, outlined in provision C.8. of the Order, is GRANTED.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
