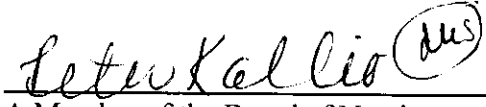
On February 12, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On July 11, 2019, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in screens, access to controlled substances and reduction in AA/NA meetings. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for access to controlled substances and a reduction in screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than 28 screens per year and one annual hair test.
2. Respondent's request for a reduction in AA/NA meetings is hereby DENIED. Respondent request was denied to insufficient time under the Bard Order.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
