On October 8, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.


On November 14, 2019, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens, a reduction in AA/NA meetings, and a monitoring interruption for the period of December 17-24, 2019. Based upon the information of record, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug screens and AA/NA meetings is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency of screens is reduced to not less than 28 per year and one annual hair test. Respondent's frequency of AA/NA meetings is reduced to one per week.
2. Respondent's request for a monitoring interruption for the period of December 17-24, 2019 is hereby GRANTED. Respondent will be required to undergo one hair test after her return, as notified by the Approved Program.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
