On November 18, 2015, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) revoking Respondent’s license to practice medicine and surgery (#34598-20). Pursuant to the Order, Respondent was not allowed to petition for reinstatement of licensure for a period of two years following the effective date of the Order. On November 14, 2018, the Board denied Respondent’s petition for reinstatement of licensure and imposed additional limitations should he petition for reinstatement of licensure in the future. These limitations included the completion of an AODA assessment and a hair and/or nail test through an Approved Program.


On August 21, 2019, the Board considered Respondent’s request for reinstatement of his license. Based on the information of record, the following is entered:


ORDER

1. Respondent’s petition for reinstatement is hereby approved upon Respondent’s submission of an application after all requirements are met, and contingent upon successful completion of the SPEX exam with a passing score as determined by the Board or its designee.
2. Upon Respondent’s successful completion of all requirements for licensure, the Board reserves the right to impose certain conditions and limitations on his license as deemed appropriate.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
