On January 14, 2016, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On October 10, 2019, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens and AA/NA meetings. Based upon the information of record, the following is entered:

ORDER


1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens and AA/NA meetings is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency of screens is reduced to not less than 14 urine screens per year and one annual hair test. Respondent's frequency of AA/NA meetings is reduced to biweekly.

2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.

3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
