On August 6, 2016, the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete four (4) hours of education on the topic of "ethics," and four (4) hours on the topic of "confidentiality" within 90 days. The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to comply with the education requirements and as a result the following is entered:
