On August 17, 2016, the Wisconsin Social Worker Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Work Examining Board ("Section") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's advanced practice social worker certificate for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her certificate is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On November 27, 2019, the Section's designee considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Section's designee finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than 28 urine screens per year and one annual hair test.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
