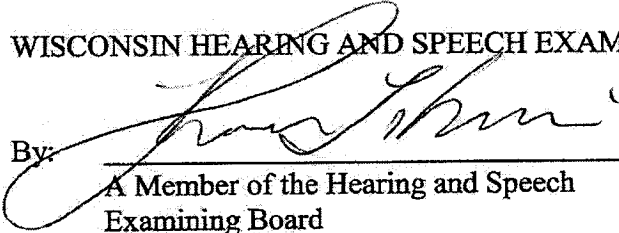
On October 10, 2016, the Wisconsin Hearing and Speech Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's hearing instrument specialist license with certain terms and conditions.

On January 8, 2019, the Board considered Respondent's request for removal of the limitations and the return of his license to full, unrestricted status. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:
