On October 24, 2016, the Wisconsin Professional Counseling Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Work Examining Board ("Section") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional counselor license with certain terms and conditions. Pursuant to the Order, Respondent's license may be suspended, without hearing, for substantial or repeated violation of any provision.

Information has been received that demonstrates Respondent has ceased to participate in the approved drug monitoring program without Section approval and is therefore in violation of the terms of the Order. As a result, the following is entered:

1. Respondent's professional counselor license (#4222-125) is hereby SUSPENDED until further notice.
