On November 3, 2016, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's pharmacist license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On October 28, 2019, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens and Alcoholics Anonymous and/or Narcotics Anonymous ("AA/NA") meeting attendance. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

#### ORDER

- 1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to no less than 36 screens per year.
- 2. Respondent's request for a reduction in AA/NA meeting attendance is hereby GRANTED. Respondent shall attend AA/NA meetings at a frequency no less than once per week.
- 3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
  - 4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
