On November 8, 2016, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board ("Board") granted Applicant a limited real estate broker license in the state of Wisconsin. Pursuant to the Order Granting Limited License ("Order") issued on the same date, Applicant may petition the Board for removal of the limitations upon the completion of at least one year of compliance with all terms and conditions, if Applicant does not maintain a trust account and the Board finds that Applicant has practiced real estate in a manner that safeguards the public.

On March 21, 2019, the Board considered Applicant's request for removal of the limitations and the return of her license to full, unrestricted status. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Applicant's request for the return of her real estate broker license to full, unrestricted status is hereby DENIED for failure to comply with attestation in 5a of the Order.
